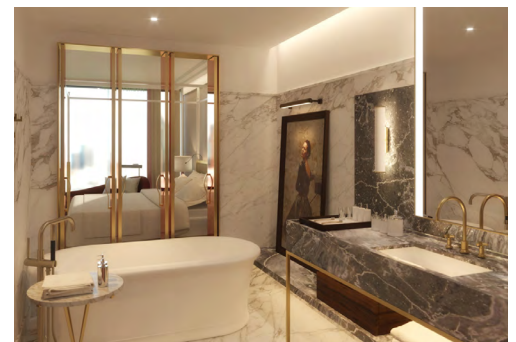
The hotel includes a 450-person ballroom, Palais des Possibles, which is one of the largest ballrooms located in downtown Montréal. It is also the only 5-star hotel with a kosher kitchen. The hotel also features 180 large guest rooms with access to the its skylit indoor pool, sauna and luxurious spa, 24HR fitness club and is the home of celebrity chef Marus Samuelsson's new restaurant, lounge, day bar, night bar and terrasse.

The new Four Seasons has already become the hub of Montréal's vibrant social scene and claiming its spot as "the landmark hotel" on Montréal's Golden Square mile.
